## JUBILEE INDEX

The Society marked its 25th anniversary by the issue of a 'General Index' of six volumes of the *Miscellanea*, compiled by James Singleton, Hon. Librarian. It was included in Vol. xxii and followed after the usual index to the volume. The present Jubilee Index includes not only ten volumes of *Miscellanea* but all the Publications to date. It is hoped that it will prove to be an efficient guide to their contents, and so encourage a younger generation to consult the volumes and to buy those of service to them. Prices have been substantially reduced and single parts may be bought at similar rates.

The Index may be kept separate, or bound up at the end of Vol. xxxvii, where the coloured cover will serve to distinguish it. A second copy may be obtained at a cost of sevenpence, post free, so that members may have it in duplicate and bind one copy.
