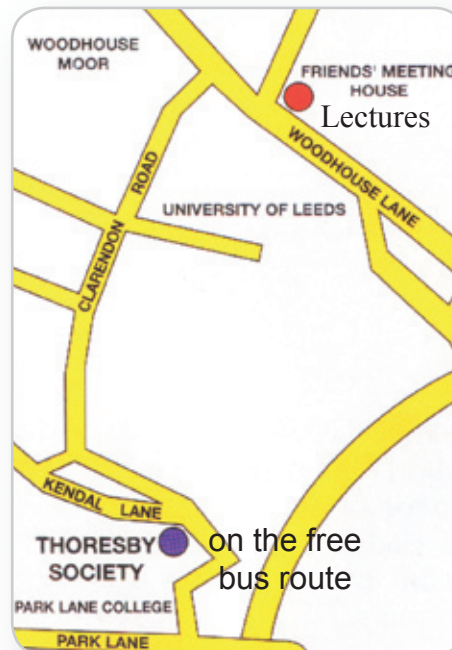

Publish annually articles, research papers and documents relating to the history of Leeds.

The Library



Use our library with its extensive collection of maps, images and books which include directories of Leeds, biographies of Leeds people and a range of archival material. We also hold a wide selection of 18th and 19th century local newspapers.

Lectures and Exhibitions



Seven lectures each year. Recent ones include "Holocaust survivors in Leeds"; "17th Century roads in Headingley" and "The Leeds "Soviet" of 1917". In 2007 we organised an exhibition to celebrate the 800th anniversary of the founding of the borough of Leeds.

Publications



Receive our annual publication free of charge. Recent publications include a detailed account of the evacuation of Leeds schoolchildren during the Second World War and a survey of the monuments and memorials in Leeds Parish Church.

Excursions and Research Days



Three excursions each year. Recent visits were to Ribbleshead Viaduct, Leeds Grand Theatre and Holbeck. We hold an annual research day on sources for local history and produce an annual survey of books relating to the history of Leeds.
